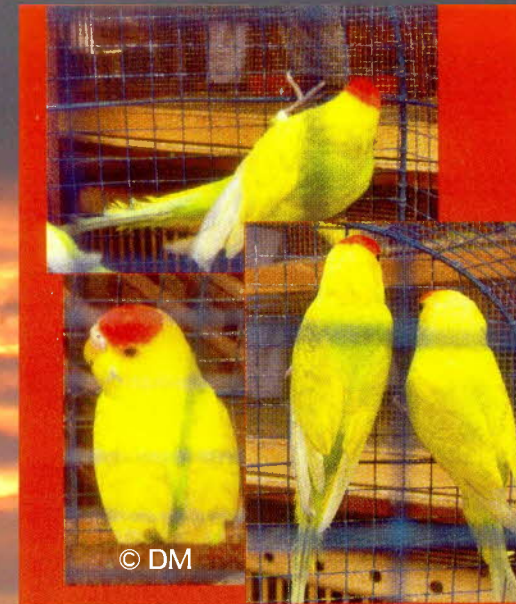


# Mutation or not...

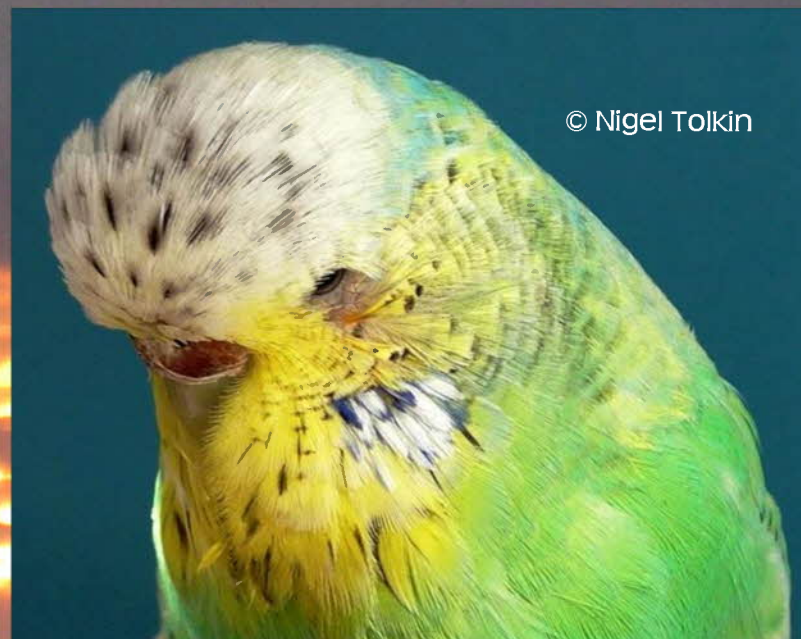

Right 3 Misty birds

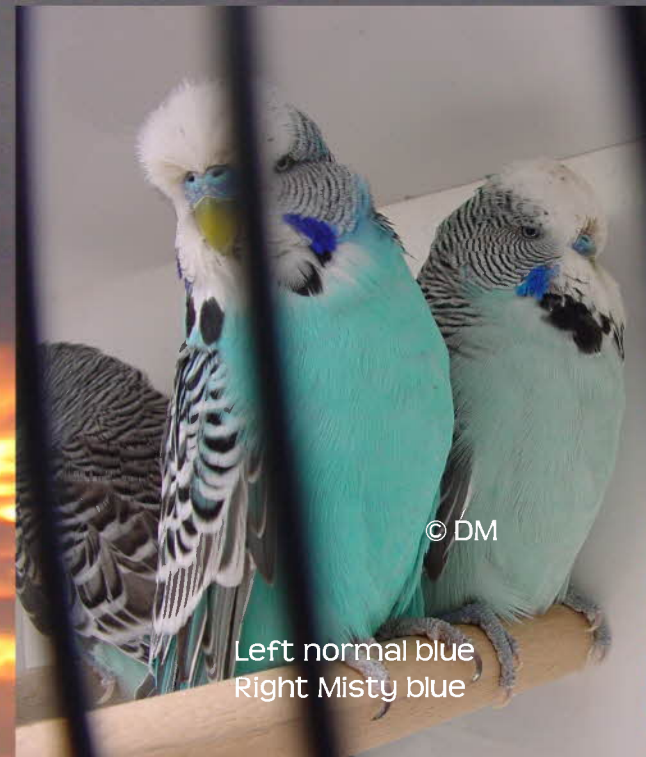
